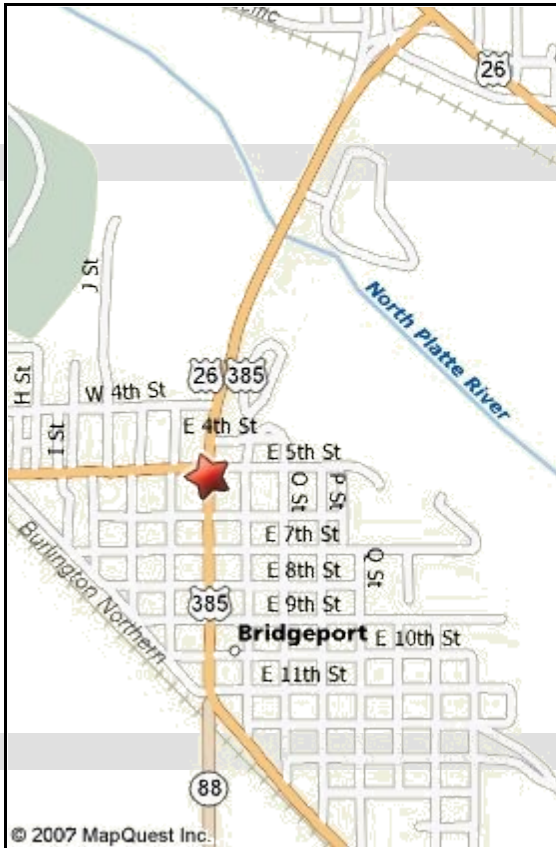

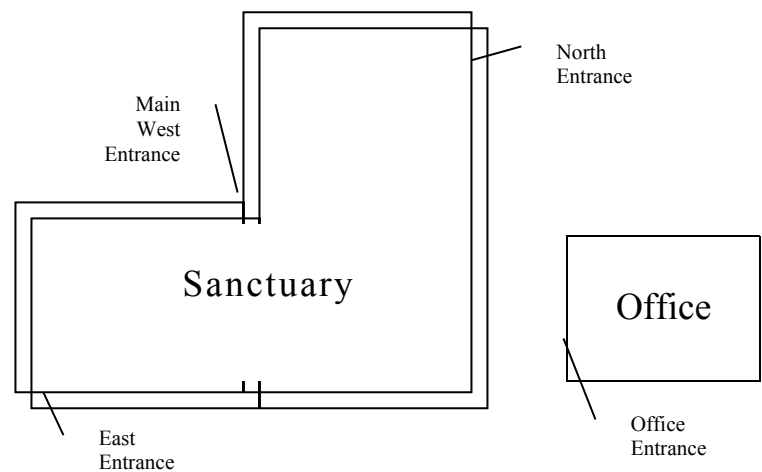
HOW TO FIND US:

THEOLOGY AND PRACTICE OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this altar in the confession and glad confidence that, as our Lord says, He gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but his very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him and with one another. (1 Cor. 10:16) Our Lord invites to His table those who trust His words, repent of (*turn from*) all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us, that they may show forth His death until He comes again. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm, (1 Cor. 11:23-29) and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith, which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, who are in doubt, or hold a confession differing from that of this congregation and the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the Sacrament, are asked first to speak with the pastor on a day prior to the celebration of the Lord's Supper.
